

New Port Road Bridge Traffic Switch, Aldinga

July 2023

As part of the Main South Road Duplication project, a traffic switch will be implemented at the new signalised Main South Road and Port Road intersection, over the new surface road bridge. This permanent opening of the new bridge will result in improved road safety and driving conditions for road users and make travel safer for pedestrians and cyclists.

What to expect

The traffic switch involves changed traffic arrangements as follows:

- southbound traffic to and from Aldinga Village will travel via the new Main South surface road and Port Road bridge, entering just south of Little Road;
- northbound traffic to and from Aldinga Village will remain on the existing Main South Road carriageway;
- a Shared Use Path connection from Flour Mill Road across the new bridge to Port Road provides access for pedestrians and cyclists: and
- a new footpath connects pedestrians from the Shared Use Path at Port Road to St Ann's Anglican Church.

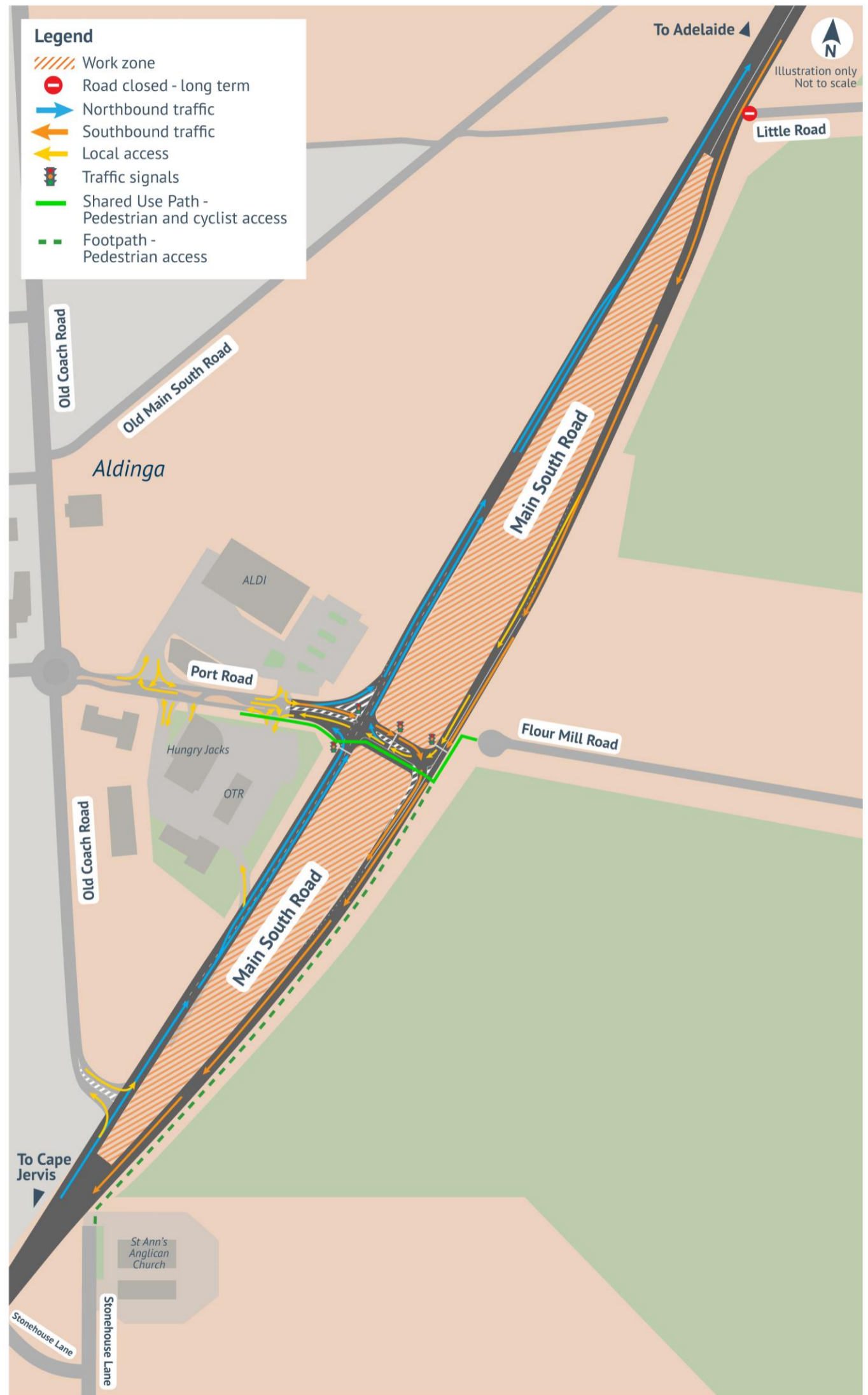
Access to local businesses remains the same.
