Traffic switch to Tatachilla Overpass and upcoming night works

Advance notice of Traffic Switch to Tatachilla Overpass and upcoming night works

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed a total of \$685 million to fund the Fleurieu Connections Main South Road and Victor Harbor Road Duplication projects. These projects are now over 75% complete and, and when finished, will result in safer and faster journeys for motorists and provide a vital boost for local tourism, communities.

Timing of work

On **Friday, 15 September 2023,** weather permitting, preparatory night works for the upcoming traffic switch to the Tatachilla Overpass will be undertaken between **7pm and 6am**.

Main South Road, between Robinson Road and Communication Road, will be closed, with access maintained for local businesses and residents with detours in place. To safely facilitate these works traffic management will be in place, please refer to Map 1 for more detail about temporary traffic arrangements.

From 6am Saturday, 16 September 2023, weather permitting, traffic will permanently move to the new Tatachilla Overpass, while works continue beneath it. To safely facilitate these works traffic management will be in place, please refer to Map 2 for more detail about permanent changes to traffic arrangements.

Post-switch night works

From Sunday, 17 September 2023 to Friday, 6 October 2023, weather permitting, night works will be required to undertake earthworks on Main South Road between Tatachilla Road and Pedler Road South. Hours of work are **7pm to** 6am. VMS boards and signage will advise of changes to traffic.

Works will include

Works will include asphalt, line marking, barrier installation and sign installation on Main South Road.

Access will be maintained for local businesses and residents at all times with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area. VMS boards will be used to advise any changes to traffic conditions.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible. You may also notice some light spill from mobile lighting towers.

Access for emergency service vehicles will be maintained at all times during these works.

Map 1 – Temporary Traffic changes to prepare for the Tatachilla Overpass Traffic Switch, in place between 7pm and 6am 10 September 2023






