Main South Road Duplication Project – Stage 1 Little Road to Aldinga Beach Road

What's happening

The Main South Road Stage 1 and Victor Harbor Road Duplication projects are nearly complete. As part of the completion works there will be ongoing changes to traffic conditions and some night works throughout the remainder of March and April 2024.

Work across the project includes:

- **Traffic management:** removal of safety barriers, signage installation, asphalt work and road safety audits and inspections:
- **Road maintenance:** line marking, line marking removal, signage repairs, guard rail and safety barrier installation/removal, pavement repairs and weed spraying; and
- **Dust Management:** including road sweeping and watering down if dry and windy weather.

Please find over the page a summary of planned night works throughout March and April.

How this affects you

Some noise and light spill can be expected, but we will try to keep these disturbances to a minimum. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.

The confirmed dates for these works will be advised on our VMS boards and on our website closer to the time. In addition, the Community team will contact you if the work directly impacts your property.
