Project Update – September 2024

We're doubling the capacity of Main South Road from Aldinga to Sellicks Beach to improve safety and make your journey more reliable.

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed a total of \$810 million to the Main South Road and Victor Harbor Road duplication projects, which are being delivered by the Fleurieu Connections Alliance (FCA).

Work is well underway on Stage 2 of the Main South Road Duplication between Aldinga and Sellicks Beach. Driving through the area, you will have seen a lot of activity along the corridor in preparation for the next stage of construction.

Stage 1 is done and dusted.

And that's a wrap! The Victor Harbor Road and Main South Road – Stage 1 duplications are complete. From landscaping to line-marking, the finishing touches have been completed in recent weeks. Both roads are now open to traffic without restriction.

The new Shared Use Path is open and buzzing with cyclists and walkers. Enjoy stunning vineyard views, discover incredible Kurna artwork, and don't miss the ocean-themed Coast to Vines underpass and new rest nodes along the way.

DID YOU KNOW?

- more than 145,000 tonnes of asphalt was used and 400,000 cubic metres of earthworks were moved.
- 99% of the 912 jobs facilitated on Stage 1 were South Australian workforce.
- approx. 50 tonnes of steel used was manufactured here in South Australia.



Stage 2 starts to take shape.

On Friday 6 September, traffic moved to the new permanent asphalt, which will eventually become the new northbound on/off ramps, between Hart Road and Old Coach Road.

On Monday 16 September, another milestone was realised, when traffic on Aldinga Beach Road was moved onto its new alignment. These milestones will ensure we can get on with building the new interchange on schedule.

We'll be constructing a new east-west signalised bridge for Aldinga Beach and Willunga travellers, and Main South Road vehicles will travel underneath through a new underpass.

The Shared Use Path constructed as part of Stage 1 will continue and extend the full length of the duplication, terminating at Sellicks Beach Road.

Works on Stage 2 are expected to be completed in 2026, weather permitting.

We're working hard to minimise impacts.

We are committed to reducing construction impacts on the community. We continually seek new ways to manage and mitigate these effects.

New Aldinga Interchange



We have achieved some big milestones over the past few months, with piling work on the new interchange commencing, as well as traffic switches on Main South Road and Aldinga Beach Road.

More than 39,000 tonnes of asphalt will be laid and over 320,000 cubic metres of earth will be moved to build the new interchange. The new bridge, which will connect the realigned Aldinga and Aldinga Beach Roads, is expected to be open to traffic in early 2025, followed by the underpass opening in 2026.

Day works ongoing

Most of the works on Stage 2 will continue to be undertaken during the day, between 7am and 7pm Monday to Saturday. During this time, you can expect an increased number of vehicles and construction equipment moving through the area and changed traffic conditions. Please take care when travelling in the area and follow the directions of traffic controllers and updated signage.

Night works

To minimise impacts to the wider community, we will occasionally need to undertake some night works within the Stage 2 area. When needed, these works will be undertaken between 7pm and 7am Sunday to Friday. If we need to undertake works near your property, we will contact you in advance to let you know. Night works can include road closures or restrictions.

Upcoming milestones

We're committed to delivering the Main South Road Duplication - Stage 2 project on time and to the highest standards. Each milestone represents a significant step forward in improving infrastructure, enhancing safety, and supporting the growth of our community.

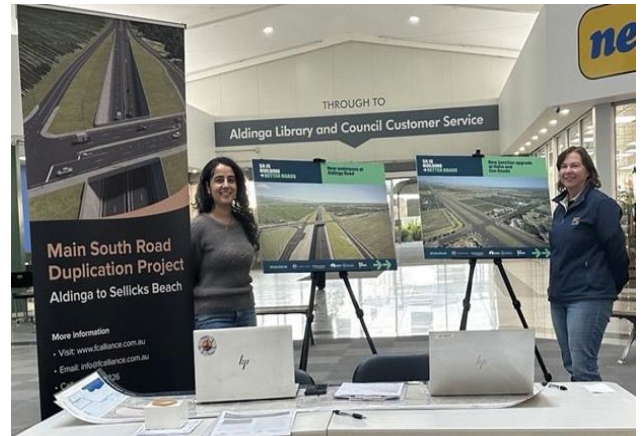
