Upcoming Road Closures

We're doubling the capacity of Main South Road from Aldinga to Sellicks Beach to improve safety and make your journey more reliable.

The \$810 million Fleurieu Connections project is jointly funded by the Australian and South Australian governments.

Works are continuing across the project as we move closer to road opening and overall completion. Over the coming weeks, several access changes and temporary road closures will be required to safely facilitate final construction and finishing works.

These activities are an important step in delivering the completed road, improving safety and connectivity for all road users once open. Some of these upcoming changes are detailed on the following pages.

Main South Road temporary night closures

From 7pm Monday 17 November 2025, for approximately four weeks, Main South Road between Port Road and the Aldinga Interchange, inclusive of the southbound on ramp, will be closed for all remaining construction and asphalt works as well as final line marking. Please see below for a detour map. **Main South Road will reopen at 7am each morning.**

During these night works, all Heavy Vehicles will be required to detour via Victor Harbor Road and Aldinga Road. VMS signage will be in place to direct you.
