Upcoming Road Closures

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We're doubling the capacity of Main South Road from Aldinga to Sellicks Beach to improve safety and make your journey more reliable.

The \$810 million Fleurieu Connections project is jointly funded by the Australian and South Australian governments.

Over the coming weeks, several access changes and temporary road closures will be required to safely facilitate final construction and finishing works.

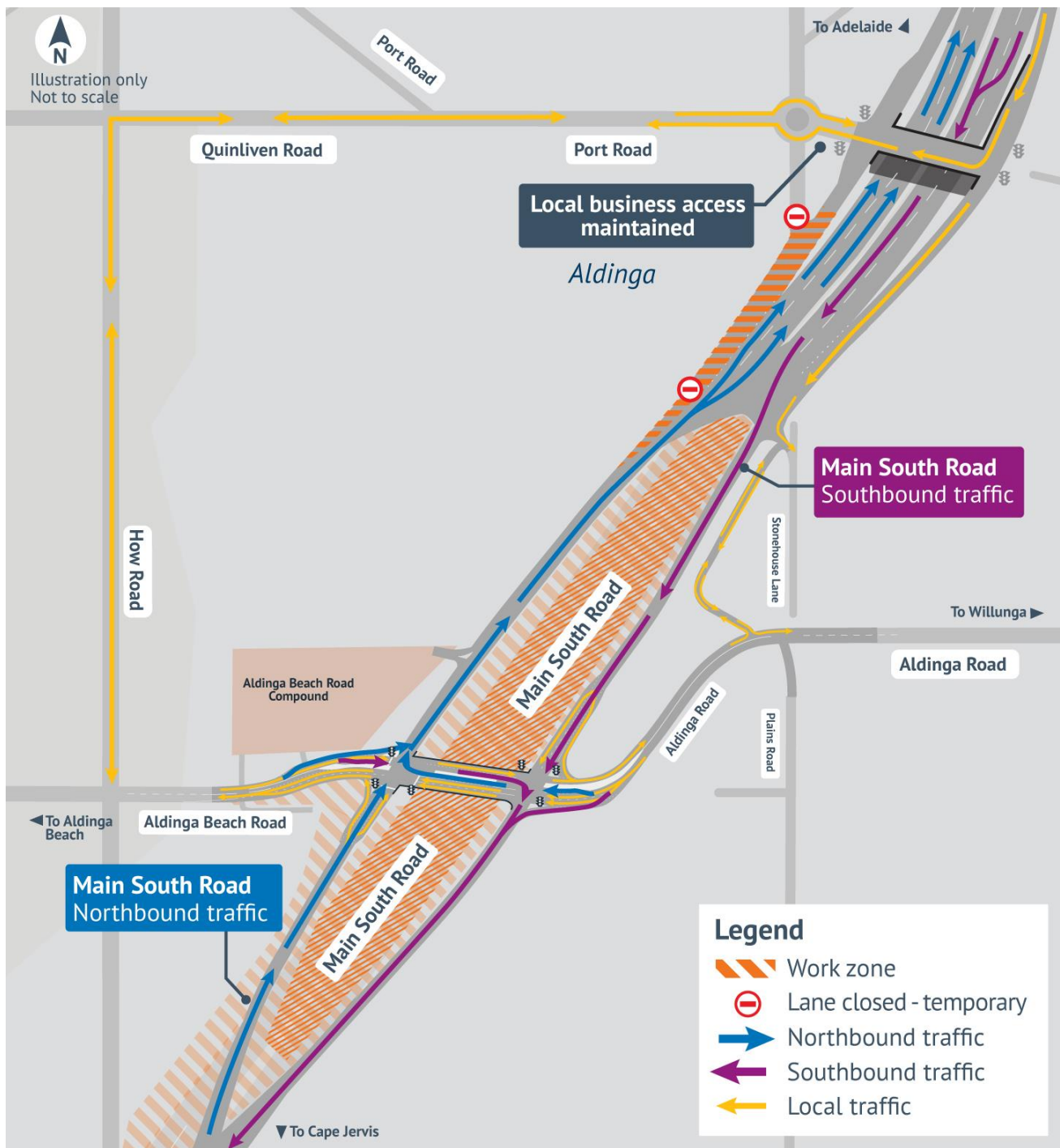

Temporary closure of Old Coach Road and off ramp

From **7pm Friday 7 November 2025** to **7am Monday 10 November 2025**, the off ramp to Port Road at Aldinga, including the junction of Old Coach Road, will be temporarily closed (**24 hours a day**). A detour will be in place via Aldinga Beach Road, How Road and Port Road. Access to businesses on Old Coach Road and Port Road will be maintained at all times via Port Road.

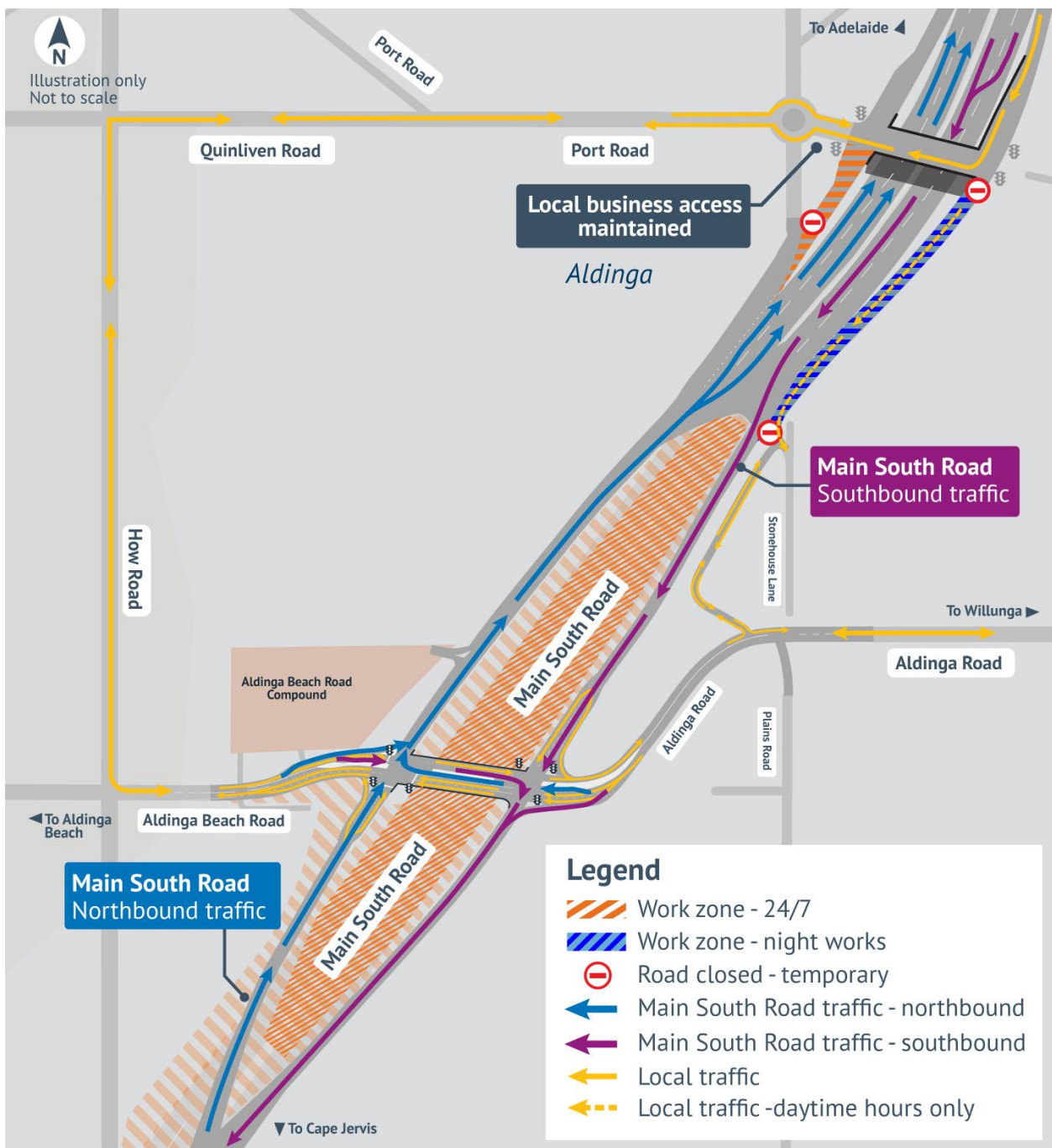
Works at the Aldinga Road and Plains Road will be undertaken at the same time as the works at Old Coach Road. Visit our website for more detail and detour information.



Port Road off ramp extended closure

From 7am Monday 10 November, the Old Coach Road junction will reopen to traffic while the off ramp to Port Road at Aldinga will remain closed **24 hours a day**. Motorists can access the OTR service station via Old Coach Road and Port Road. **The ramp is expected to reopen 7am Monday 17 November 2025.**

Also from Monday 10 November, the southbound on-ramp from Port Road to Main South Road will be temporarily closed at night for approximately two weeks. Access to Main South Road will be via Port Road, How Road and Aldinga Beach Road. Stonehouse Lane access will be maintained via the new link road from Aldinga Road. **The ramp will reopen each morning from 7am.**



During these night works, all Heavy Vehicles will be required to detour via Victor Harbor Road and Aldinga Road. VMS signage will be in place to direct you.





Aldinga Road and Plains Road weekend closures

We recently advised that Plains Road and Aldinga Road (between Main South Road and east of Plains Road) will be closed on three weekends to complete final construction and asphalt works. This area will be closed between 7pm Friday and 7am Monday on the following weekends:

- 31 October until 3 November
- 7 November until 10 November; and
- 21 November until 24 November.

During this time, a detour via Bayliss Road and Malpas Road (northbound) or Hahn Road and Ryan Road (southbound) will be in place.

Localised speed and lane restrictions

Until late November, we'll also be undertaking finishing works on and around Aldinga Beach Road and Aldinga Road.

These works will include construction of the new Shared Use Path, asphalt works, kerb installation, signal works and street lighting.

Works will occur both during the day and at night as required. Access will be maintained at all times. If there is a need to restrict access, you will be contacted directly.
