

VICTOR HARBOR ROAD & MAIN SOUTH ROAD INTERSECTION

The intersection at Victor Harbor Road and Main South Road has not been impacted by the Main South Road and Victor Harbor Road duplication Projects.

What to expect

Traffic will travel through the intersection as follows:

- southbound traffic travelling on Victor Harbor Road will remain on two lanes and no longer merge into a single lane;
- northbound traffic travelling on Victor Harbor Road will approach the intersection on two lanes, which will become:
 - three right turn lanes onto the existing Main South Road northbound carriageway;
 - one left turn slip lane onto the existing Main South Road southbound carriageway.

Pedestrians and cyclists can use the Shared Use Path (SUP), which starts from the corner of Main South Road, travels to Robinson Road, along the western side of Victor Harbor Road.

Access to local businesses remains the same.
