

VICTOR HARBOR ROAD, ROBINSON ROAD AND QUARRY ROAD ROUNDABOUT



As part of the Victor Harbor Road Duplication project, the intersection at Robinson Road and Quarry Road will become a roundabout. Quarry Road will be realigned to meet Robinson Road. The roundabout will provide continuous traffic flow and safety improvements.

What to expect

Traffic will follow the usual rules for navigating a roundabout.

Southbound Victor Harbor Road traffic entering the roundabout will be able to:

- turn left onto Quarry Road from the left lane;
- travel through the roundabout to continue south;
- turn right onto Robinson Road from the right lane;
- perform a U-turn using the right lane.

Northbound Victor Harbor Road traffic entering the roundabout will be able to:

- turn left onto Robinson Road from the left lane;
- travel through the roundabout to continue north;
- turn right onto Quarry Road using the right lane;
- perform a U-turn using the right lane.

Traffic entering the roundabout from Robinson Road will be able to:

- turn left onto Victor Harbor Road (northbound);
- travel through the roundabout to Quarry Road;
- turn right onto Victor Harbor Road (southbound);
- perform a U-turn.

Traffic entering the roundabout from Quarry Road will be able to:

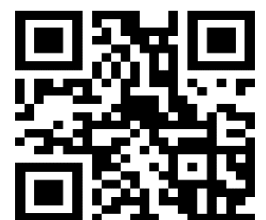
- turn left onto Victor Harbor Road (southbound);
- travel through the roundabout to Robinson Road;
- turn right onto Victor Harbor Road (northbound);
- perform a U-turn.

Pedestrians and cyclists can use the Shared Use Path (SUP), which starts from the corner of Main South Road, travels to Robinson Road, along the western side of Victor Harbor Road.

Access to local businesses remains the same.
