We engage early with businesses during the project construction phase to identify and discuss potential project impacts, as well as any specific business needs and requirements including:

- the potential impacts of noise, dust, and vibration and how these will be proactively managed;
- how we will keep them informed about road closures and changes to traffic conditions;
- potential visibility impacts to businesses as a result of construction activities;
- the construction program; and
- business requirements;

We also make sure businesses know how they can easily get in touch with us during the construction program if they have any question or concerns.

Partnering with small business:

We will liaise regularly with businesses throughout the project and provide timely and accurate information. We will proactively work to address any concerns and specific issues experienced by small businesses as a result of the project.

Support activities could include early briefings on works, specific signage, and assistance with operational requirements during construction.
